Specialist Sarah Beckstrom of the U S Army was 20 years old at the time of her death. Staff Sergeant Andrew Wolfe is 24 years old and a member of U S Air Force, is listed as critical condition from the last report. Both were deployed from the West Virginia National Guard. I will just ask that you think of them for a minute and pray for them, and hope that Sergeant Wolfe makes a full recovery. We all wore the uniform; we all made some sacrifices.

Note as of 12-15-25 Sergeant Wolfe has been released from hospital and is recovering.

Note please remember 2 soldiers killed in Syria, reportedly by ISIS as of this report.
